The 455 kW genset had to be broken down and shipped in pieces as it had to be flown in and was too heavy to go up in one piece. Cummins came to site and assisted in the reassembly of the genset. The genset was supposed to be identical to the existing one, but, as usual, nothing is ever that easy. After modifying the fuel, exhaust and jacket water piping, the genset was filled and tested with the aid of Cummins. The last we heard this genset is currently running the town.
